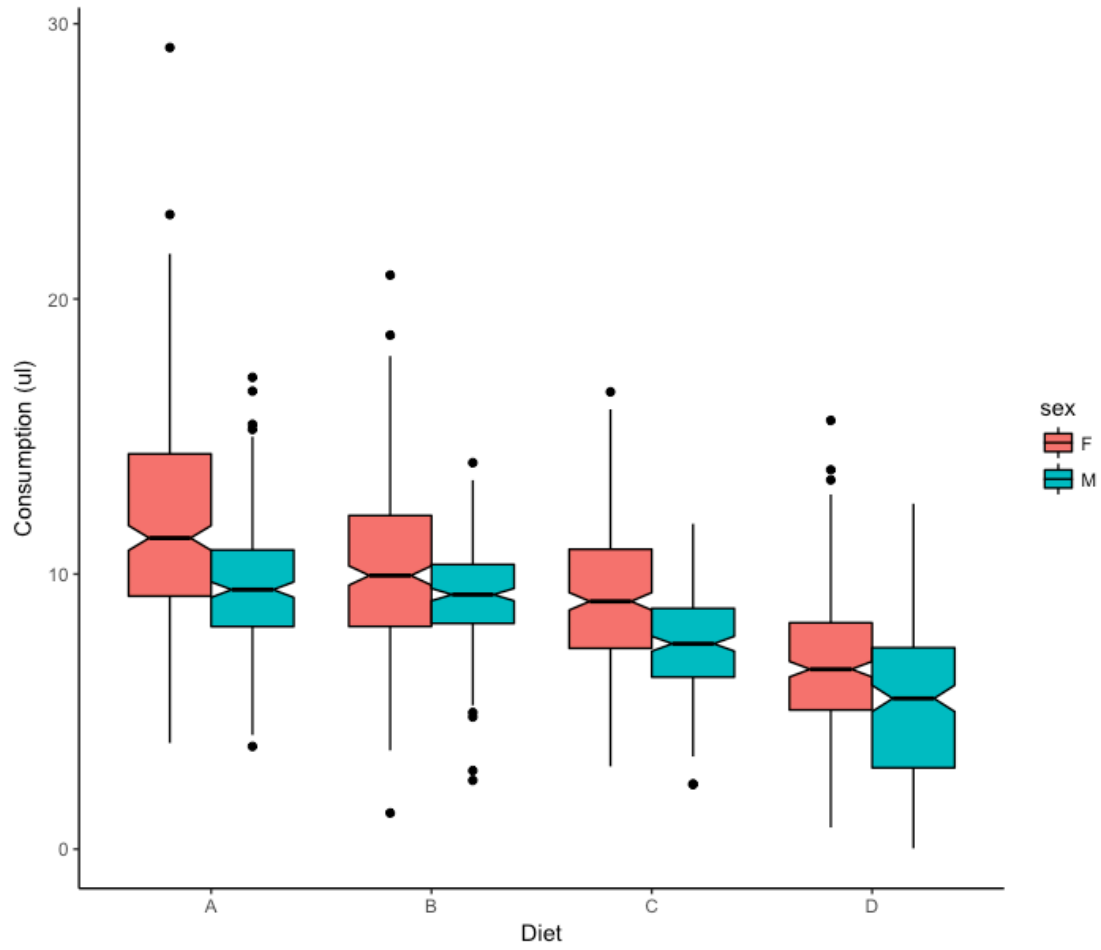


Figure S3.3: Amount of protein and carbohydrate consumed (mg) across all four nutritional rails.

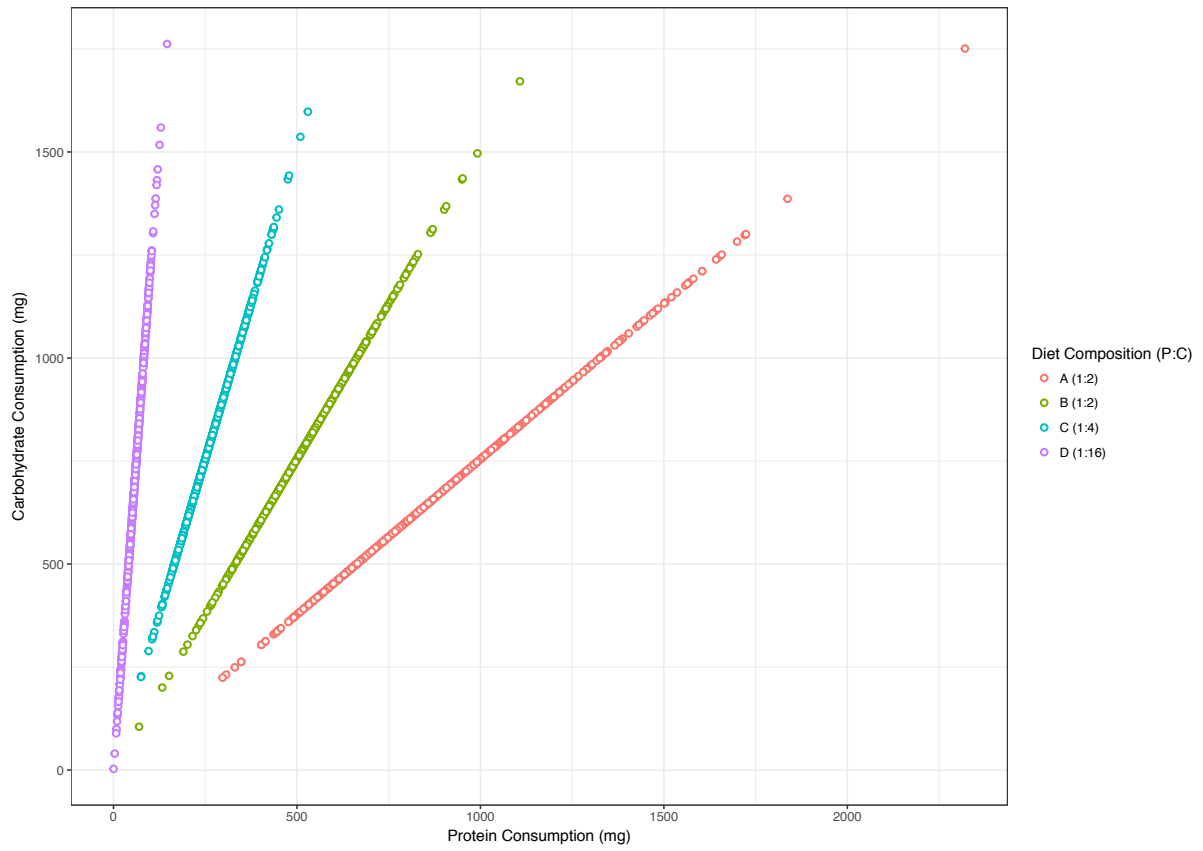

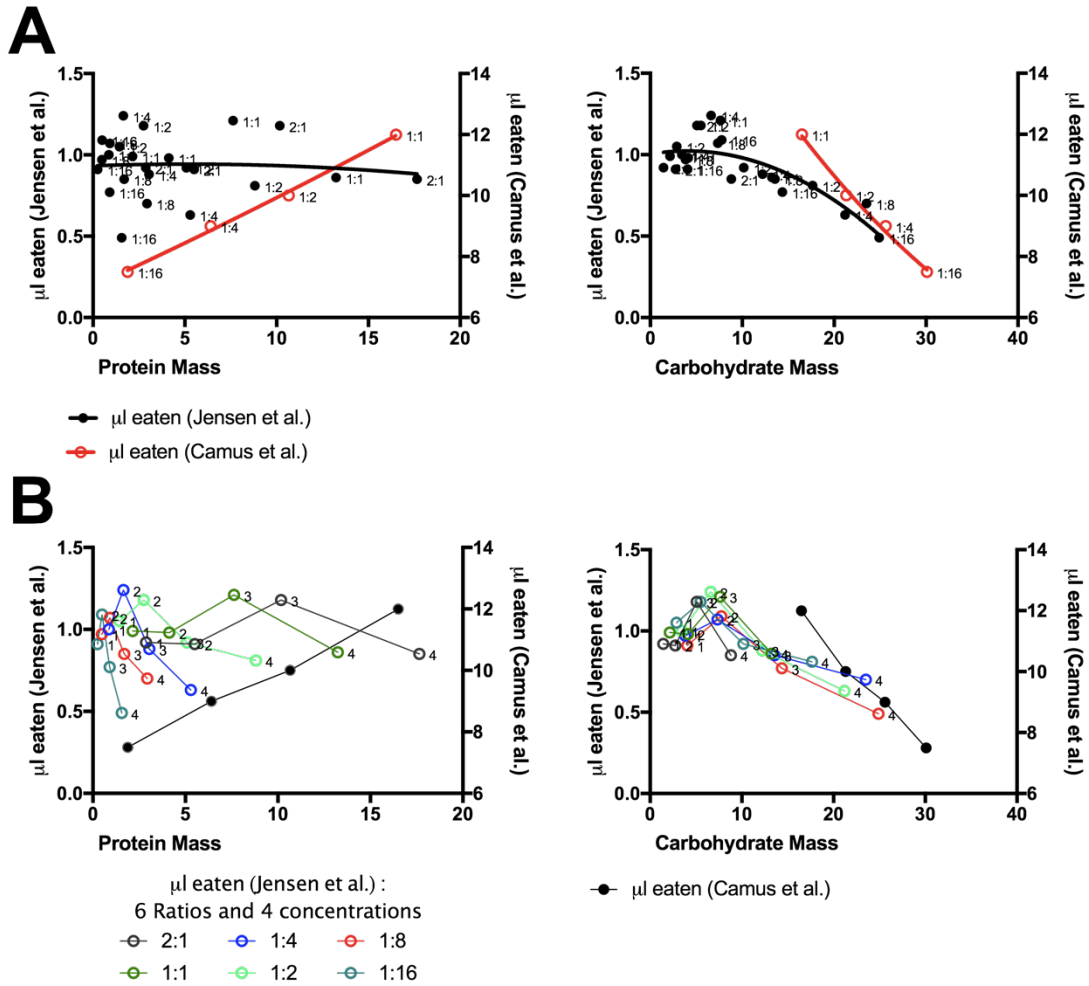
