The upper part of the graph represents the 2 SD intercondylar distance (ICD, positive) and the lower part the 2 SD intermalleolar distance (IMD, negative) and the mean values are represented in the middle of the graph. Note, measurement of IMD and ICD cannot replace a regular careful orthopedic assessment due to high complexity of leg deformities (e.g. torsion of limbs) in many patients.
