


FIG. 1 General Plan of Kephala on Keos.




FIG. 2 Kephala on Keos. Houses Y and Z, in Area L.










FIG. 7 Panormos on Naxos. The EC IIIA Settlement.




FIG. 8 Emporio on Chios. Architectural Remains in Area A.




FIG. 9 Thermi on Lesbos. Plan of Town IIIA.




FIG. 10 Troy Ia-b. Plans of Houses 103 and 102:






FIG. 11 Phaistos on Crete. EM I Building Remains





FIG. 13 Mt. Kynthos on Delos. Buildings in the












a-b. Building XI.




c. House E ( Phase I )


FIG. 17 Ayia Irini on Keos.

BRONZE AGE FINDS AT AKROTIRI, THERA




a. Distribution of Early & Middle Bronze Age finds.








a. EH House.




b. Remains of an apsidal house.




a. Zygouries. EH II House Y.







FIG. 24 Tiryns. Horizon 1-4


Plan of the EM IIa and EM IIb settlements.




b. Knossos. The EM IIa House










FIG. 30 Diagrammatic Plan of Walls of Troy I





FIG. 32 Troy I. Fortifications of the Late and Middle Troy I




a. Plan of the well-like structure






Mt. Kynthos on Delos.




a. House E ( Phase 2 ) Scale 1:150




b. House D Scale 1:150


FIG. 35 Ayia Irini on Keos, Ceramic Phase III








FIG. 40 Topographical plan of Chalandriani -Kastri,






FIG. 41 Kastri on Syros. Plan of the EC IIIA Citadel.





FIG. 43 Lithares. Plan of the EH Settlement




a. Orchomenos. EH Round Structures


b. Manika in Euboea. Plan of the settlement in Sector III,




Plan of the EH Settlement




b. Ground Plan of the " Weisses Haus "




a. Zygouries. Plan of the EH Settlement




b. Berbati. EH Buildings B/R and A






a. Buildings and Fortifications of Lerna IIIC




b. Plan of Building BG of Lerna IIIC






FIG. 51 Akovitika. The EH Structures





FIG. 53 Malia. EM II Architectural Remains




FIG. 55 Thermi on Lesbos. Plan of Town IV




FIG. 56 Plan of walls of Troy IIIc  
( After Blegen et al. 1950 )





FIG. 57 Troy II. The "House of the King"






The layout of the settlement at Paroikia, on Paros. ( After Rubensohn 1917 )




a. Map of Melos, showing the location of the EC IIIIB settlement-sites.


aThe area around the Town of Phylakopi, showing the location of the tombs.






AIGINA V: Groundplan of the fortified settlement.




a. TNS:Horizon 10 (EH III).

of the 2nd Phase.




c. LERNA IV:Structures  
of the 3rd Phase.










FIG. 68 Ay. Irini. The Area of the Temple














a. The Apsidal Structures on Mt. Kynthos.






PLAN 3 The Main Excavated Area

fig. 10)




PLAN 2 Poliochni III


